Canoe trips starting from Galeairy Lake Access Point #13 or Rock Lake Campground Access Point #9

Canoe Trips from Access Points #9 and #13

Day long and half-day trips originating from or ending at Galeairy Lake are a perennial favourite. Rent a canoe from Opeongo Outfitters at Rock Lake and canoe back to Whitney for an all-day one-way adventure. Or rent a canoe in Whitney and explore Galeairy Lake at your leisure. Favourite stops include Rock Lake Dam, the warm white sand of Perley Farm/Farm Bay, and Purcell Cove where you can take an excursion to a waterfall swimming hole. One of the islands has swing rope you can use to jump into the water as well.

Permit	Only if you go into Rock Lake
Time	All day or half day
Distance to access point	1-2 km
Distance	Varies, easily 20km+
Fitness level	Beginner to moderate
Children	If accompanied by an adult (experienced canoer).
Infants & Toddlers	If accompanied by an experienced adult.
Pets	Permitted
Dangers	Standard water perils
Bathrooms	Available at the boat launch in Whitney, and Rock Lake campground

What to bring

Clothing	Swimsuit and towel PFD
Nutrition	Lots of water Prepacked lunch, snacks
Other	Typical canoeing supplies: first aid kit, sunscreen etc.



Time	Activity
7:00am	Depart Whitney for Rock Lake access point #9
7:45am	Arrive at Rock Lake access point. Purchase permit if necessary, Bio- break. Pick up canoe.
8 :00am	Depart Rock Lake access point by canoe and travel back to Whitney with stops at any of the locations along the map.
5:00pm	Arrive at Whitney access point #13 and enjoy dinner in the village.
8:00pm	Enjoy the sunset at Galeairy Lake Beach
9 :00pm	Arrive at Four Corners Algonquin
